STANDARD COURSES

They are suitable for people who want to learn Polish to communicate successfully in everyday situations and / or in business situations. The syllabus of the course is designed to meet the students’ individual needs.

Levels: A1 to C2

Lesson plan – designed individually.

Length of course: minimum 40 lessons. (All lessons are 45 minutes long)

LANGUAGE WORKSHOPS – ‘ POLISH WORTH KNOWING – STARTER’

LANGUAGE WORKSHOPS are intended for people who want to begin to study Polish. During the classes the students will acquire basic words and phrases as well as basic grammar rules, which will enable them to communicate in simple everyday situations (such as greeting or introducing people, asking the way, making “small talk”, etc.) They will also practise Polish pronunciation.

Levels: A1 / A2

Lesson plan: three lessons five times a week.

Length of course: 2 weeks (30 lessons - all lessons are 45 minutes long)

Individual or group courses.

INTENSIVE COURSES

Intensive courses “Polish worth knowing – the ability to speak fluently and accurately” (or total immersion courses) are intended for people who have to learn basic Polish or improve their knowledge of Polish in short time in order to communicate in everyday situations and / or business situations. The course focuses on functional and communicative aspects of the language. The students practice all four language skills, yet the course concentrates mostly on speaking and listening. At basic levels reading and writing are limited to simple texts (e.g. text messages), at more advanced levels we adapt practising these two language skills to students’ needs. When studying Polish, students also familiarise themselves with Polish customs and traditions.

CS ADAMS school is located near the Old Market Square (two-minute walk), which allows us to organise the classes also outside the classroom. The students can practise the language in a natural environment, for example, when they order something in a cafeteria, do the shopping, stroll around the Old Market Square or visit the most interesting sights in Poznań. Additionally they can improve their knowledge of Polish when they have lunch together with their teacher.

Levels: A1 to C2

Lesson plan – classes five days a week (Monday to Friday) – eight lessons a day or six lessons a day

Length of course: minimum one week (40 lessons or 30 lessons - all lessons are 45 minutes long)

Individual or group courses.
